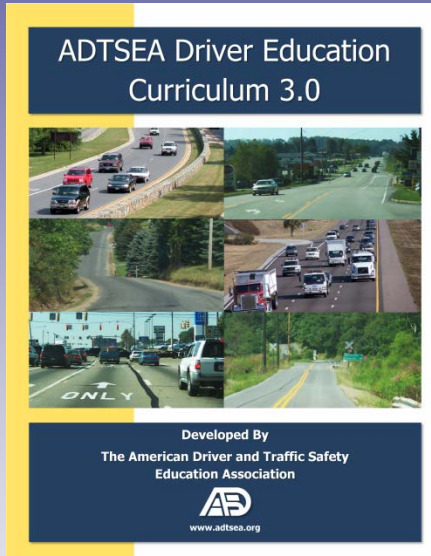

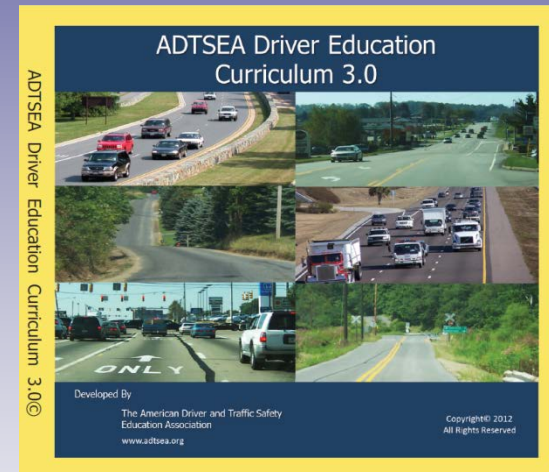

How the Current 3.0 Technology Works

- New Computer (CD-ROM) Edition released with the DVD Edition.
- CD-ROM designed to be used with a personal computer with the slides and videos incorporated.
- DVD designed to be used with a DVD player.
- Either method may be used depending on audio-visual equipment available.



Problems You May Be Having with the Curriculum?

- Are you having problems playing the curriculum? If so, what kind of problems?
- What equipment are you using it in? Is it in the CD-ROM, DVD or both versions?
- How often are you using the curriculum?



Alternative Way of Using the Curriculum

- PowerPoint presentations on a CD-ROM to play in your computer.
- Videos only on a DVD to play in a DVD player or on your computer.



How has the 3.0 Curriculum been effective or successful?

- “Gives students a more updated view of today’s driving.”
- “Most of the State’s objectives are met with this curriculum.”
- “Makes it easier for students to follow the lesson.”
- “Students gain a better understanding of what they are expected to perform by seeing it done in the videos.”



How has the 3.0 Curriculum made progress toward desired goals and objectives?

- “Each objective is found throughout the units along with additional important tips & information.”
- “It's important for each teacher to have supplement materials but with this curriculum a teacher almost doesn't need any.”
- “Answers many questions students have before they are able to ask.”
- “It is the best curriculum resource we have had to date.”



Would you recommend the 3.0 Curriculum to others?

- “It is easier to teach than the 2.0.”
- “Covers most everything (except State specific) needing to be covered in a driver ed program.”
- “Abundance of information to pull from no matter how short or long your course is.”
- “Some units are too long and redundant.”
- “Videos are good but unreliable and unpredictable.”



What Challenges or Concerns Have you Encountered with the 3.0 Curriculum?

- “Need something easier to navigate.”
- “Being able to run the DVD on my laptop without any problems.”
- “The inability to go to a specific frame.”
- “Too many slides.”
- “Knowing what is important. Lots of material and not enough time to cover it.”
- “Some videos cut short and video questions are weak.”



What Could be Done to Improve or Enhance the 3.0 Curriculum?

- “Shorten all units to 25-30 slides max.”
- “Enhance so that each frame can be accessed individually.”
- “Incorporate the steps into the video clip demonstrations as opposed to showing the video then going through the steps”
- “Less videos, more interactive activities and more examples of real life experiences.”
- “An outline that has the key concepts that need to be covered and what could be optional.”
- “Having it in PowerPoint would be better.”
